



Outreach Programs from Oxley Nature Center

Winter 2012

Make reservations now for programs brought to your classroom from Oxley Nature Center between January 11 and February 17. Smaller classes may be combined, but these are not large assembly-style programs. Because of the hands-on, participatory nature of each presentation, programs are limited to no more than 30 students in any one presentation. Even presenting 4 programs during the morning and 4 in the afternoon, that puts a limit of 240 students for the day.

Starting in 2012 every school, even Tulsa Public Schools, will be required to pay the program fee of \$2 per student. There is an additional charge of \$10 each day to defray transportation costs; save money by planning all your schools' presentations for the least number of days necessary. You may reserve as many days as you like.

2:00 p.m.	Honeybees for 18 K in Rm. 7	and	Adaptations for 25 3 rd gr. in Rm. 10.
